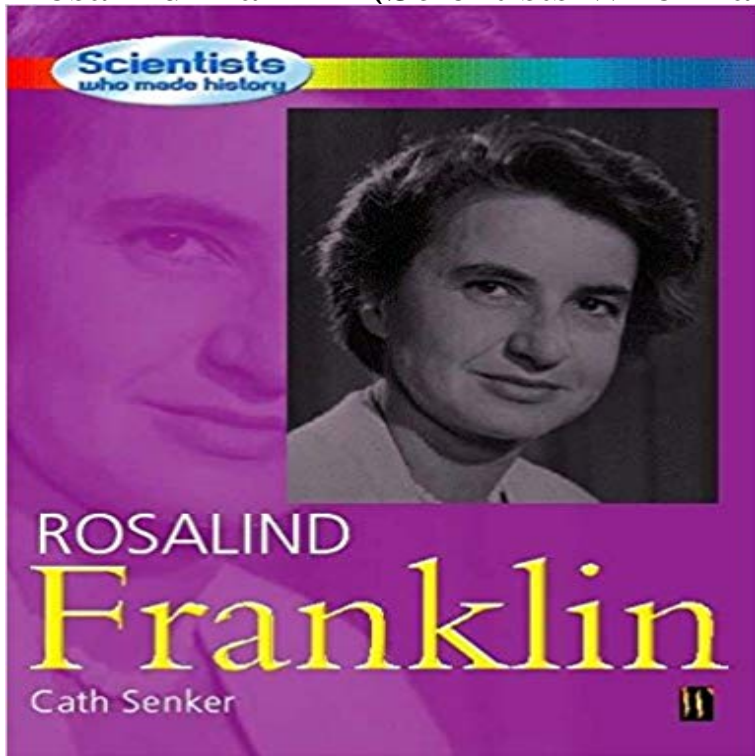


## Rosalind Franklin (Scientists Who Made History)
