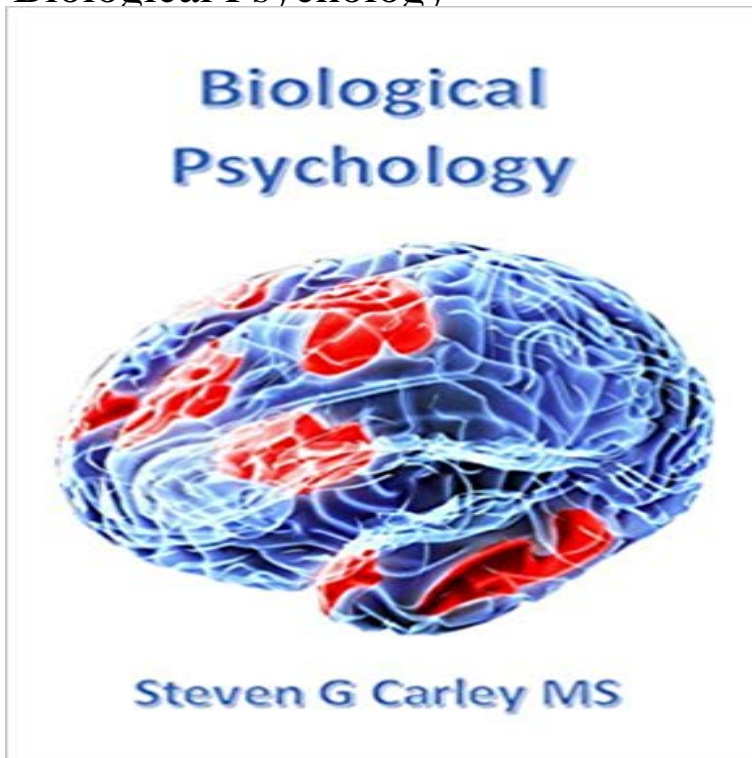


Biological Psychology
