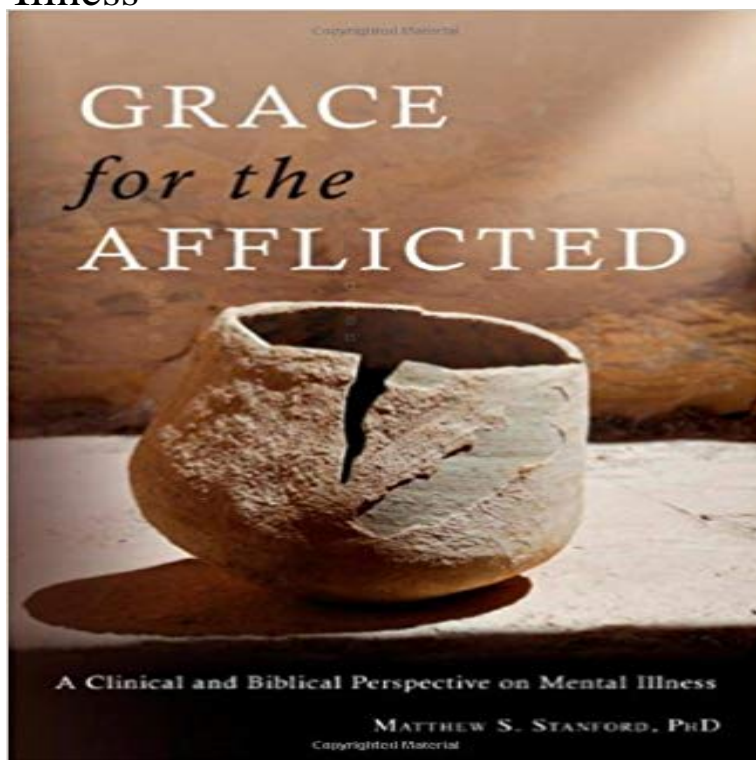


# Grace for the Afflicted: A Clinical and Biblical Perspective on Mental Illness
