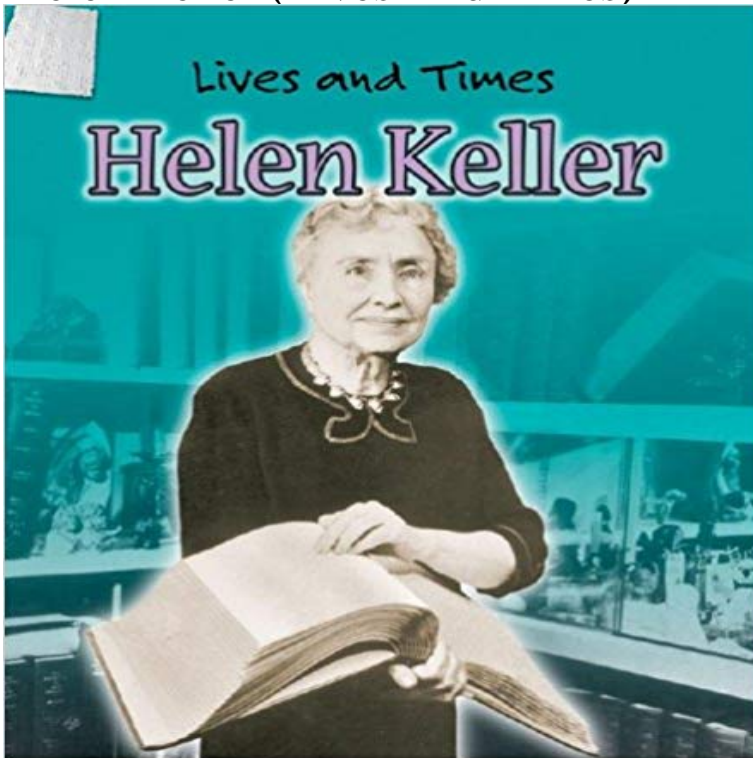


## Helen Keller (Lives And Times)
