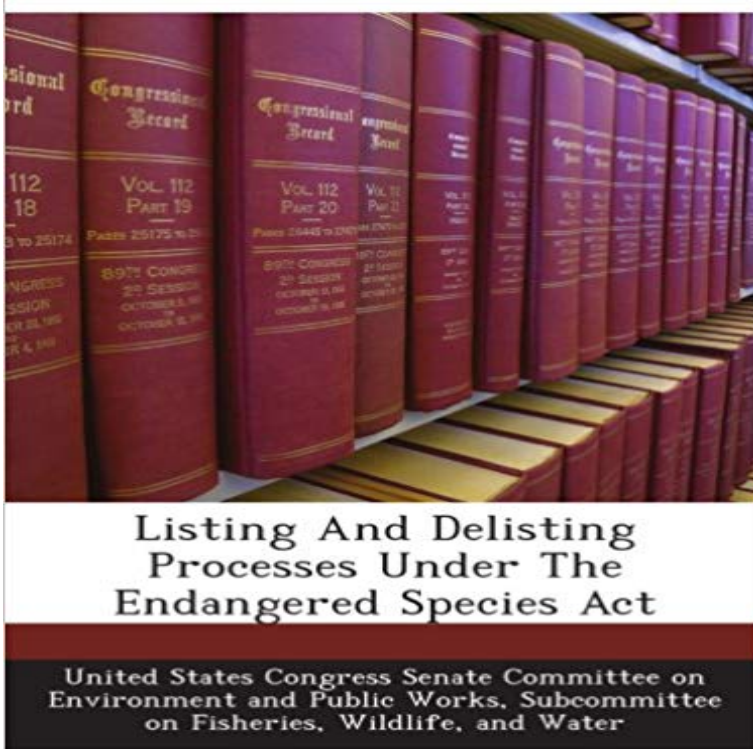


Listing And Delisting Processes Under The Endangered Species Act

Endangered Species Program Laws & Policies **Endangered** The Endangered Species Act of 1973 (ESA 16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.) is one of the few dozens . In March, 1967 the first list of endangered species was issued under the act. .
