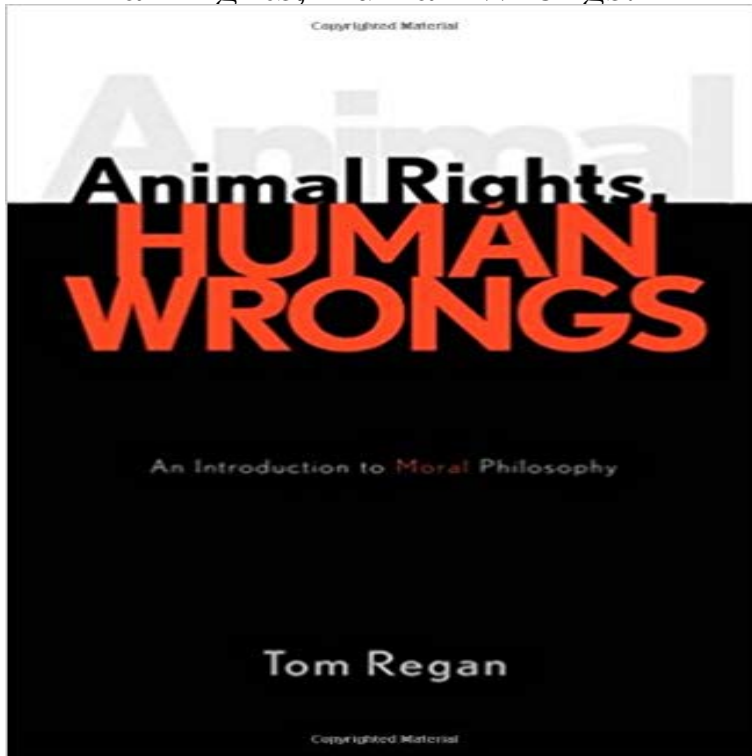


Animal Rights, Human Wrongs: An Introduction to Moral Philosophy
